The Importance of Sleep

If you were watching panorama this week on BBC 1 you will have seen a documentary about the importance of sleep for children. The programme showed very clearly that sleep affects how children feel and function. Lack of sleep can hinder performance in school, can lead to depression and can even lead to weight gain. By helping children get the recommended amount of sleep, you can improve your child's health, psychological well-being, and safety. Sleep is key to your child's growth and development as well as his/her ability to learn. Here is the general guidance on the amount of sleep children need at different stages in their lives:

- Preschool aged children 10-12 hours
- School-aged children At least 9 hours
- Adolescents (Teens) 9 hours
- Adults 7-8 hours

The documentary also highlighted the detrimental effects of tablets/phones in bedrooms. The recommendations are that children should not use mobile phones/tablets/or watch TV 1 hour before bedtime. Let's try this at home.....


