World Meeting of Families

As you may already know the World Meeting of Families (WMOF) is due to take place in Dublin from 22 - 26 August. This will be a wonderful opportunity for Irish families and families around the world to celebrate, talk about and reflect on the theme 'The Gospel of the Family: Joy to the World'. The first three days, Wednesday to Friday, will consist of a Congress, and will be made up of workshops, discussions and social events. A full programme of activities and fun events will be available for children (4-12 years) and young people (13-17 years) to enjoy.

On the Saturday evening, there will be a 'Festival of Families', led by Pope Francis in Croke Park, during which families from across the world will share stories and experiences about living the Christian life in the modern world. On the Sunday afternoon, in Phoenix Park, Pope Francis will be the main celebrant at the Final Mass. Both of these events are free-ticket events. Everyone wishing to attend either of these weekend events with Pope Francis, must register on-line at <u>www.worldmeeting2018.ie</u>

If you register to attend one day of the Congress you are guaranteed a ticket for the Final Mass. If you register only for the Final Mass itself, tickets will be provided subject to availability. More information about ticket distribution will be made available in the coming weeks and published in parish bulletins. In St. Joseph's teachers will be focusing on the theme of families in the coming months during religion lessons and assemblies.
