Primary One Arrangements

When a child's attendance falls within the range of 88% to 85% parents are alerted to this and together, with the Education Welfare Officer (EWO), a plan is put in place to rectify attendance. School starts at 9am. Any child arriving after 9am is marked late (L) on their attendance record. A child arriving after 9.15am is recorded as U which is an unauthorised absence. Attendance with a series of L or U marks will also be brought to the attention of the EWO.
